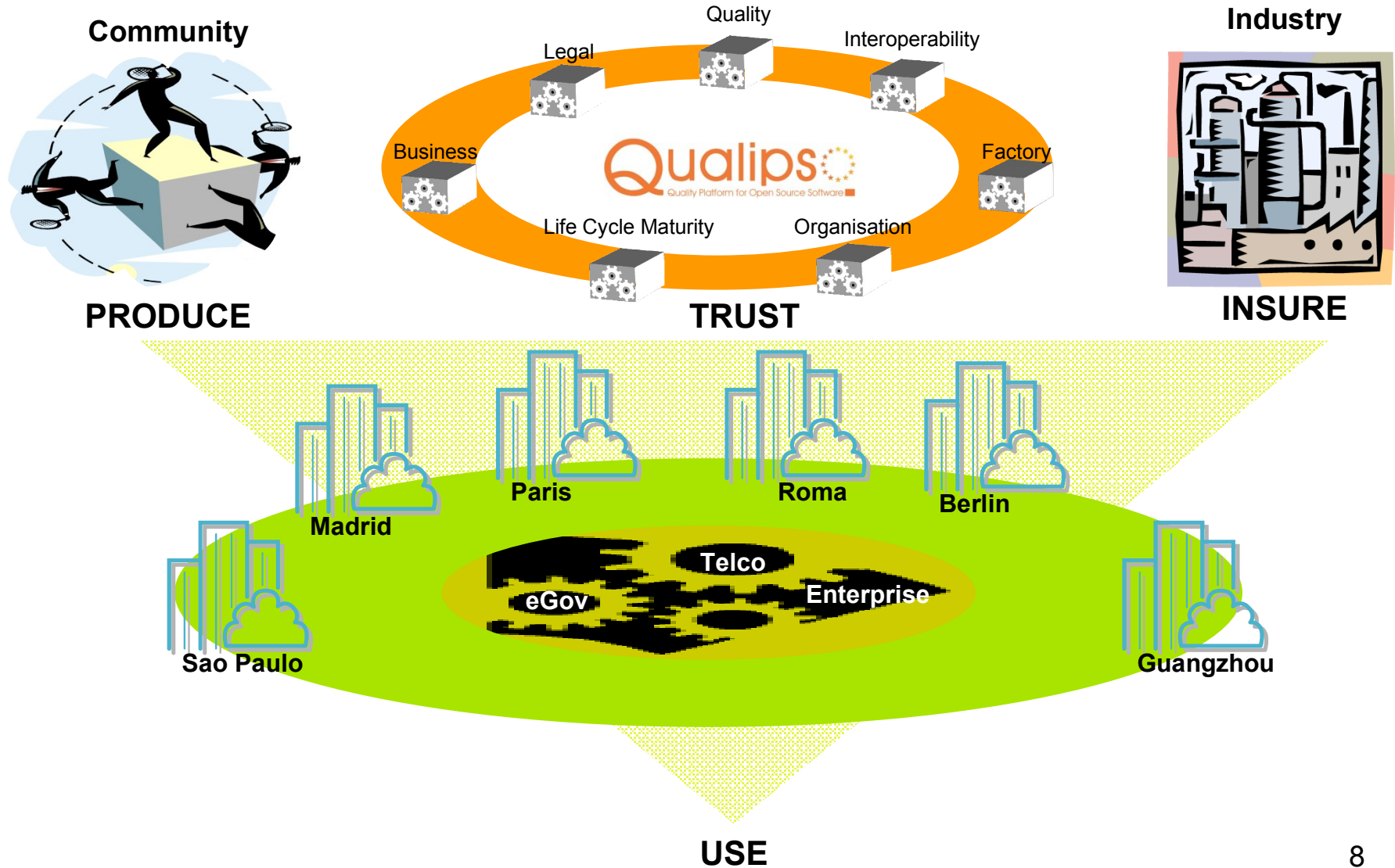

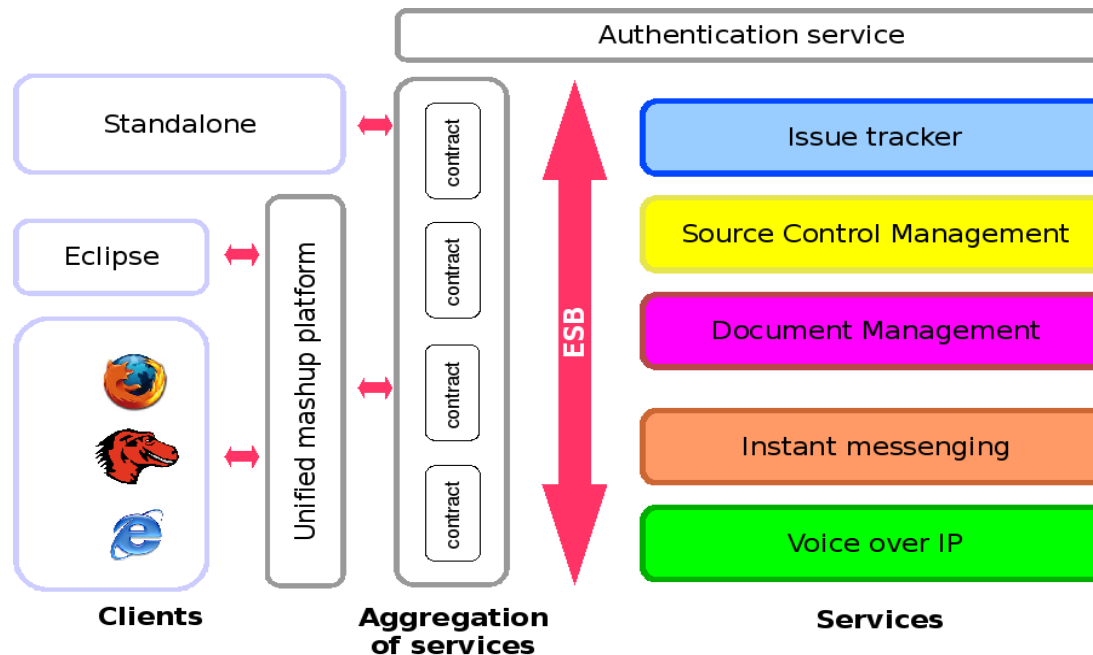
Trust cannot be claimed without being

- For an innovative framework



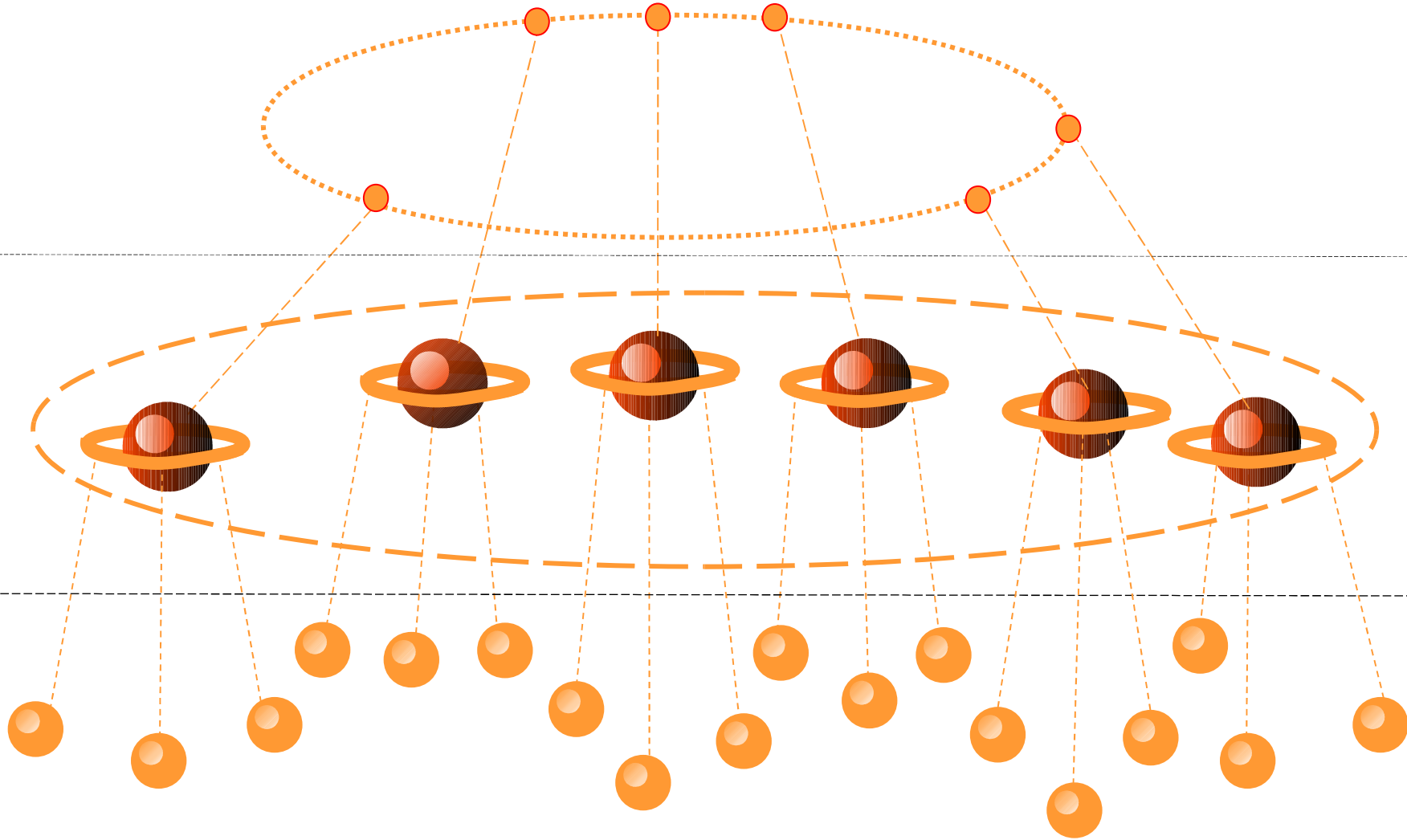
